



Western Lake Superior Sanitary District Materials Recovery Center Reuse Area

WLSSD's Materials Recovery Center (MRC) is a great place for area residents and small businesses to bring their "stuff" for recycling, reuse or disposal!

Oftentimes, unwanted items brought to the MRC are still useful. Quality, reusable items are separated and placed in a special area where other customers can "shop" for free items for their use—reducing the amount of recoverable items sent to landfills.



Participating in the Reuse program

Dropping off:

- If you believe an item is appropriate for reuse, please be sure to make note of it to the attendant when delivering materials to the MRC.
- The MRC attendant will determine if items delivered to the facility are appropriate for the Reuse Area.

Picking up:

- The Reuse Area is available to customers each day the MRC is open and will close 15 minutes before the MRC closes.
- Customers may visit the Reuse Area once per day.
- Customers may examine and select up to two items for their own use at no charge.
- Items in the Reuse Area are not to be dismantled. Customers must take items "as is" in their entirety.

Other Information:

- Safety is very important at the MRC. For the safety of all, children must remain in vehicles and be supervised by an adult.
- Smoking is not permitted.
- Customers may not approach other customers to request their materials for reuse.
- Customers may remove items from the MRC in designated reuse areas only (e.g. scrap wood, Reuse Area, etc.). Materials may not be removed from any other areas in the facility.
- Customers who want to shop the Reuse Area must sign a waiver for each each visit (available from MRC staff). A reuse pass is also filled out and returned for items selected.
- Business at the MRC should be completed in a timely manner. WLSSD does not allow loitering.
- MRC reuse services are intended to be available to all District residents. The MRC Attendants may deny or limit access to the Reuse Area if they determine that the frequency of a customer's visits exceeds the intent and purpose of the facility.
- Noncompliance with these rules may result in the revocation of Reuse Area privileges.
